

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Alpine Classic Run

Q: When is this years Alpine Classic?

A: Saturday September 19<sup>th</sup> at 10 am. Fun Run to be held at 9:30 am.

Q: Where should I go to register for the Alpine Classic?

A: You can register anytime by downloading the application from [www.JordanNY.com](http://www.JordanNY.com) or by stopping by the Jordan Fall Festival on Friday September 18<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm – 9 pm, or the day of the race at The Erie Canal Pavilion on Beaver St. across from the festival grounds.

Q: Can I pick up my race bib number and packet early?

A: Yes. Race packets and bib numbers will be available for early pick up on Friday September 18<sup>th</sup> from 6 pm - 9pm at the festival grounds.

Q: What is the cost of participation?

A: The Alpine Classic registration fee is \$15.00 if you register by *September 5<sup>th</sup>* and \$20.00 after that date. The Fun Run is free.

Q: Do I have to register for the Fun Run?

A: Although the Fun Run will be free, we do ask that you register so we can display finishers.

Q: How far is the Alpine Classic?

A: This race is 8.5 miles in distance and is comprised of dirt trails, steep inclines, water hazards and country roadway. The Fun Run is 1.5 miles and follows the Erie Canal towpath.

Q: Am I allowed to train on the race route prior to the day of the race?

A: Unfortunately some of the race will run along private property and we ask that you do not train before hand.

Q: Will there be water stations?

A: Yes there will be water stations along the route for runners and we ask that you do take advantage of these stations, as the route is long and grueling.

Q: I am not a runner but would like to participate. How can I do this?

A: You can participate either in the Fun Run as a walker or by volunteering your time to help with the Alpine Classic. Please contact the [race director](#) if you'd like to volunteer your time.

Q: Can I run the Alpine with my dog, or with a stroller?

A: You cannot run with your pet, a baby stroller or a head set along the Alpine route as it is too difficult a terrain and would not be safe. If you'd like you may participate in the Fun Run.

Q: Is there an age limit?

A: Those participating in the Fun Run should be at least 8yrs of age. There is no age limit for the Alpine Classic. However, those under the age of 18 must have a parental signature, and all participants must sign a waiver that they are physically fit to run this race. Awards will be given out to the top 3 male and female finishers and a special Senior award. Certificates will be issued for finishers in 5-year age groups.

Q: Can participants stay and take part in the Jordan Fall Festival after the race?

A: YES! Please stay and enjoy all the Jordan Fall Festival has to offer, food, games, music, rides, arts & crafts, pre-read book sale and much more!
